

Huntley Hills Elementary & Montessori School – Reopening of School Procedures

General Information:

The purpose of the reopening school procedures is to provide guidelines for students and families who choose to participate in the face-to-face (F2F) school environment; assuring children that school is a positive, safe, and loving

place. In addition, the guidelines to keep teachers and staff safe during F2F instruction. This will include building relationships, practicing safety protocols, and reestablishing the routines of face-to-face school.
